

Golden Ocean takes extra cover with D'Amico deal

Kamsarmax is the latest ship in Golden Ocean stable to be fixed out on period contract.

John Fredriksen's Golden Ocean Group has locked a kasarmax bulker into a one year contract with Italian operator D'Amico.

The charterer has taken the 81,000-dwt Golden Ginger (built 2012) at \$13,650 per day. Chief executive officer Birgitte Vartdal confirms the charter when contacted by TradeWinds.

She says the company largely employs its tonnage on the spot market, but has taken some coverage while the terms are attractive.

Golden Ginger comes off a nine months charter to Jaldhi at \$12,000 per day.

Golden Ocean bought the ship as Prime Ginger for \$31m in January 2014.
